- Cathy Hobart continues to do an excellent job as Bookkeeper.
- The NYS Library Grant work has been completed and has been spent down.
- Two hundred people have signed up for the Turkey Trot so far and donations are up from last year.
- Pete noted that discussions are needed for the 2020 TFL budget in early 2019. The 2020 TFL Budget is presented to the school board in March 2019. We need to identify Budget priorities for the 2020 Budget.
